3. Cookies

The website uses cookies, which are small text files saved on the user's device. These files are used to:

- ensure the proper functioning of the website (so-called technical cookies),
- analyze visit statistics (e.g. using Google Analytics),
- remember user settings (e.g. language, consent to cookies).

Types of cookies used:

- Necessary - enabling the proper functioning of the website,
- Analytical - helping to collect anonymous visit statistics,
- Functional - remembering selected user preferences.

Cookie management

During the first visit to the website, the user may consent to certain types of cookies (in accordance with the principle of so-called "layered consent"). The user may also change the settings for cookies in their web browser at any time or delete them completely.

Remember that disabling cookies may affect some functionalities of the website.

4. External tools

The Site may use external tools, such as:

- Google Analytics – to analyze traffic on the site (with IP address anonymization enabled),
- reCAPTCHA – to protect the form from spam (applies to, for example, application forms),
- external form systems (e.g. Google Forms or similar).

Each of these tools may use its own cookies – in accordance with the provider's privacy policy.
